Our School students will receive guidance and counseling in-house regarding preparation towards IGCSE Examination, moreover, our students do not have to go to any other Test Centre for Test counseling, admissions and taking examinations – the students will be taking examinations in their own School environment – but with stringent invigilation controls on par with Standards set by the University of Cambridge.
